INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
- Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS – SHOW REGULATIONS

Closing Date for Entries is 8:00 PM, Friday, September 30, 2011 after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or changed, except as provided for in the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows.

All Entries are to be Mailed with Fees to Patricia Reilley, Show Secretary, 531 High Rock Rd, Fitchburg, MA 01420-1554. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable after closing by mail with printed confirmations of entry. Should such acknowledgement not be received by the exhibitor within a reasonable time, please notify the Show Secretary.

Entries Not On Official AKC Entry Forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable.

No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures.

A Recording Fee of 50 cents will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show or Obedience Trial. This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (American Kennel Club Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2).

Declination of Entries. The Irish Wolfhound Association of the Garden State, Inc. may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the Irish Wolfhound Association of the Garden State, Inc. or any official thereof.

Canadian Exhibitors must submit entries with checks drawn on U.S. accounts or with international money orders in U.S. funds.

Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Secretary will add a collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Errors on Entry Forms: Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

No Refund for Duplicate Entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if an entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Entry Fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbance or other acts or conditions beyond the control of the Club or the Show Secretary it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

The Show Will be Open from 7 A.M. to 7 P.M. each day, Sunday-Monday, Oct 30–31, 2011.

Consult Judging Program for time of judging.

Dogs May Arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Judges Are Not Required To Wait For Dogs. They will adhere as closely as practicable to the Judging Program. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. IWAGS and the Show Secretary have no obligation or responsibility to provide service through a public address system or other means for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

This event may be cancelled due to extremes in weather or other conditions considered to be deleterious to the health and safety of dogs, exhibitors, judges and fanciers. No refund of entries will be made in such case.

The Show Committee has designated the entire show hotel grounds as part of the show site. An Event Committee may be held for any hotel complaint including, but not limited to, failure to clean up after your dog and destruction of hotel property.

The show giving Club, the Show Secretary, their agents, employees, etc. assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DIRECTIONS

From Manhattan

Take the George Washington Bridge to Route 4 to Route 208 to I-287 South to Skyline Drive. When Skyline Drive ends, take a right on Greenwood Lake Turnpike (Route 511). Take the second right onto Sloatsburg Road. Watch for sign for Shepherd Lake – Turn right on Morris Rd and continue to follow signs for Shepherd Lake Recreation Area.

From Upstate New York

Take I-87 to exit 15A. From 15A take Route 17 North. Exit at the sign for Ringwood and West Milford. That is Route 72, also called Sloatsburg Road. Ringwood Manor is about seven miles down on the right pass the manor to sign for Shepherd Lake, turn left on Morris Rd and follow signs for Shepherd Lake Recreation Area.

From Southern and Central New Jersey

Take I-287 North to the Wanaque exit (55). Take Ringwood Avenue (Route 511) north. Eventually it will become Greenwood Lake Turnpike. Take the second right after Skyline Drive onto Sloatsburg Road. Watch for sign for Shepherd Lake – Turn right on Morris Rd and continue to follow signs for Shepherd Lake Recreation Area.

Turn right on New Clarkstown Rd CR-35A (go 0.3 mi.) Turn right on Overlook Blvd. (go 0.1 mi)

From Hotel to Shepherd Lake at Ringwood State Park (Show Site):

Take New York State Thruway (I-87/287) North to exit 15A. From 15A take Rt 17 North. Exit at the sign for Ringwood and West Milford. That is Route 72, also called Sloatsburg Road. **OBEY ALL SPEED LIMITS ON THIS ROAD – STRICTLY ENFORCED!!!** Ringwood Manor is about 7 miles – pass the manor to sign for Shepherd Lake, turn left on Morris Road and follow signs for Shepherd Lake Recreation Area.

Irish spotting is the marking preferred in the country of origin which is white on the feet (all four preferred, but any are eligible), and chest and tip of the tail.

NON-REGULAR (ADDITIONAL) CLASSES Involving Multiple Dog Entries:

As the judge's decision in the Non-Regular Classes involving Multiple Dog Entries is based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won these classes.

STUD DOG CLASS – For Stud Dog and two or more of his Get. It is not necessary that the Get be under the same ownership as that of the Stud Dog. The Stud Dog may be entered separately in one of the regular classes, or if a Champion of Record in Best of Breed Competition, but MUST be entered in the Stud Dog Class, the Get MUST be entered in one of the regular classes. The Stud Dog shall be considered as one entry and requires one entry fee, this being the regular fee plus the additional class fee if the Stud Dog is entered in another class. The Stud Dog must be shown in the ring with the Get. The class will be judged on the merits of the Get.

BROOD BITCH CLASS – Same as for the Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud Dog and Produce for Get.

BRACE CLASS – Two dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of two handlers. Both dogs competing in brace competition must have at least one common owner.

TEAM CLASS – Four dogs of the same recognized breed or variety that are similar in appearance, performing in unison, and presented by a maximum of four handlers. All dogs competing in team competition must have at least one common owner.

GENERATIONS TROPHY- Three generations or more. Primary Entrant must have been bred by the owner. All generations must be direct descendants from the Primary Entrant.

1st Generation: Father / Mother

2nd Generation: Son / Daughter from the 1st Generation primary entrant

3rd Generation: Son / Daughter from the 2nd Generation entrant

Subsequent generations not limited to single entries

The Breeder of the Primary entrant must be the Breeder of either the sire or the dam of each subsequent generation.

All dogs must be entered in another regular or non-regular class at this show.

Neutered Irish Wolfhounds are eligible for this class.

Each dog must have its own handler (does not have to be the owner).

The Breeder must be present to accept an award but is not required to handle any entrant.
